# Fit For APrincess Herringbone Hat by Lisa Gubbels <br> www.knítsnthings.wordpress.com 

This hat was inspired by the Snowflake Queen Pattern

- A princess coat deserves a matching hat!

Enjoy!


Size ; Toddler. The finished hat is about 7" tall and 17 " unstretched around. To make a larger size, simply add another 15 st repeat (circumference) and add extra 6 row repeats (height) as needed.

Needles; 4 mm circular and/or double pointed needles.
Yarn; worsted weight, less than one ball
Contrast yarn; | used Patons 'carmen' in ivory. I think any of the 'fluffy' yarns would work great depending on the colours and what you like!
yo = yarn over
$p=$ purl
$k=k n i t$
p3tog = purl next three sts together
$k f b f=k n i t$ into the front, back and front again of the stitch. One becomes three.

ssk = slip one stitch knitwise, slip second stitch knitwise, knit two stitches together

Pattern Stitch - German Herringbone in the round

1. *yo, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{p} 2, \mathrm{p} 3 \operatorname{tog}, \mathrm{p} 2, k 3, y o, \mathrm{p}^{2}$ Repeat from * 6 times on this and every other round.
2. *k4,p5,k4, p2
3. *yo,k4, p1, p3tog, pi,k4,yo,p2
4. *k $5, p^{3}, k 5, p^{2}$
5. *yo,k5, p3tog, $k 5, y o, p^{2}$
6. *k6,pi,k6,pz

Cast on 90 sts using cable cast on or any stretchy cast on you prefer.

- Beginning with row 1 , work Pattern a total of 6 times around, placing markers at start of round and between repeats.
- Work 6 pattern rounds 4 tímes - total of 24 rows or approximately 4" For a taller hat, work further repeats to the desired number of inches. Remember we'll be adding the fluffy band later which also adds inches.


## Begin Decreases

- Rnd i ~*yo,ki,ssk,p2,p3tog,p2,k2tog,ki,yo (78 sts)
- Rnd $2 \sim$ * $k 3$, p $5, k 3, p^{2}$
- Rnd 3 - * yo, $k 3$, pi,p3tog, pi,k3,yo
- Rnd 4 - *k4, p3,k4, p2
- Rnd 5-*k4,p3tog,k4,p2 (66 sts)
- Rnd 6 - *k4, pi,k4, p2
- Rnd 7 -*k2,p1,p3tog,pi,k2,p2 (54sts)
- Rnd 8 ~*k2, p3,k2, p2
- Rnd9 - *k2, p3tog,k2,p2 (42 sts)
- Rnd 10 - *k2,p 1,k2,p2 but end last repeat with $p 1$ instead of $p 2$ and place new beginning of round marker.
- Rnd 11 ~* 2 2tog, P 3 , ssk ( 30 sts)
- Rnd $12 \sim$ * $1, \mathrm{p} 3, k i$
- Rnd 13 ~*ki,p3tog,ki (18 sts)
- Rnd 14 - *ki,pi,ki
- Rnd 15 -*slip i,k2tog.psso
- Rndi6-k6

Cut yarn and draw cut end through 6 remaining stitches.
Secure end and weave into wrong side.

Using 'carmen' or your chosen contrast yarn and
beginning with right side facing, pick up stitches as
follows;

- beginning in a yo at right side of a p2 dividing section, ${ }^{*} 1$ stitch in yo, istitch in $p 2$ divider, 1 stitch in yo, 4 stitches up one side of scallop, 1 stitch in top of scallop, 4 stitches down side of scallop. Repeat 6 times.
- Place markers between sections and at beginníng of round.
- Next round - knít

Rounds To Repeat

- Rnd 1 -*slip i, k2tog, psso, k4, kfbf,k4 (repeat 6 times in round)
- Rnd 2-purl

Work these two rounds until band is the size you desire, ending with the first round. Mine is about an inch.

- Bind offloosely in purl
